F. Footnotes

1. No individual course can count towards more than one requirement within the Biology major.

2. BIOL 18a,b is restricted to biology majors. If you begin in another major and switch to the biology major after taking the non-majors' biology laboratory series, BIOL 12a and 12b, you will need to add one more 4-credit biology lab course (such as BIOL 18a, 18b, 152 or 159) to complete the core laboratory requirement for the major.

3. Students matriculating after Fall 2020 cannot use more than one of BIOL 51a, ECON 83a, or PSYC 51a toward the major.

4. Candidates for BIOL 99 must petition the department during the fall of their senior year and submit a thesis. Candidates for the Senior Honors Program must also orally defend a thesis.

5. 2-credit lab courses count as half of one elective. 4-credit labs count as a whole.

6. These are suggested courses. Any course approved for the Biology major with the Oral Communication, Writing Intensive, or Digital Literacy designations may be used.
